## **Challenging and Important Words Bookmark**

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Share books with your child that have words that are challenging to read but important to understanding the information in the book. Examples: **necessary**, **descend**, **resource**.

Before reading together, skim the book to find three challenging and important words that appear often. When you read together:

- 6. Point to word in the book and read it to your child.
- 7. Have your child look at the word and repeat it.
- 8. Explain what the word means and why it is important to understand the word for this book.
- 9. As you read the book, stop at the challenging and important word to talk about it.
- 10. Point to the word again and ask your child to read it and explain what it means.
