Map and Swoop Vowel-r Syllable Pattern

Directions

- 1. Remind your child that a **syllable** is a word part with a vowel in it. Usually, a word has as many syllables as it has vowels. **Vowels** are a, e, i, o, u. The other letters (like b, c, d, f) are **consonants**.
 - Cat has one syllable.
 - Picnic has two syllables (pic-nic).
 - Yesterday has three syllables (yes-ter-day).
- 2. For this activity, practice the vowel-r syllable pattern. A vowel-r syllable pattern always has **at least one vowel** followed by an **r**. The **r** always comes directly after the **vowel**. Examples include st**art**, f**er**n, doc/t**or**.
- 3. Give your child the map and swoop vowel-r syllable pattern activity sheet. Ask your child to:
 - Read the word.
